ArtGrounds.com Rules and Regulations

Revision 13, September 2007

Please refer to the ArtGrounds.com End-User License Agreement (“EULA”) for a list of terms and definitions.

The following is a set of rules which are to be followed at all times by the User. Use of ArtGrounds.com services (including Sketcher) is an acknowledgment and agreement that you will follow these rules. Failure to follow these rules could lead to a ban and either criminal or civil remedies.

In certain situations, the overall pattern of behavior on an account or a set of linked accounts may be determined to be disruptive or abusive, even if no one single act clearly violates any specific policy. In such cases, Tenament reserves the right to determine what patterns of behavior are defined as "high-maintenance" or "disruptive" and may take action against the account(s), ranging from a simple request to moderate the high-maintenance behavior, to total lockout of all linked accounts.

1. Do not draw sexually explicit images in any of the General rooms.
2. Do not draw any blood or gore in General 1.
3. Do not draw excessive blood or gore in Generals 2 and 3.
4. Do not swear in the General rooms.
5. Follow all of the instructions of the Administrators and send any complaints/comments about their conduct to: contact07@tenament.com.
6. Do not argue with other users.
7. Do not speak in all caps.
8. You must use more than one word per line in the chat box.
9. Use proper English or whatever language you choose to speak in (ie. no slang).
10. Be polite.
11. Do not delete the Sketcher layers.
12. Do not erase or otherwise sabotage other users' drawings.
13. Do not draw larger than 1/12th the size of the canvas.
14. Do not box off an area to draw in.
15. Do not reserve space.
16. Erase before you leave.
17. Do not let anyone else use your ArtGrounds.com account.

18. Do not use this service to: Harass, threaten or embarrass another User of the Services or to cause distress, unwanted attention or discomfort of such User, or any other person or entity. Tenament does not condone harassment in any form and may suspend or terminate the account of any User who harasses others. Personal attacks, such as those based on a person's race, national origin, ethnicity, religion, gender, lifestyle choice, disablement or other such affiliation, are strictly prohibited.
19. Do not post or transmit sexually explicit images, or point or reference to such images in the general rooms.
20. Do not transmit any unlawful, harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, hateful, racially, ethnically or otherwise objectionable content. If User engages in vulgar or abusive language online, even if masked by symbols or other characters, or engages in other impermissible behavior, User may receive a warning, or be temporarily or permanently excluded from one or more games, bulletin boards, chat areas, or User's membership may be terminated immediately and User may be subject to civil liability and/or prosecution by law enforcement authorities.
21. Do not Scroll or carry out any action with a similar disruptive effect. "Scrolling" is defined as repeatedly causing the screen to roll faster than Users are able to type onto it.
22. Do not impersonate any person, including, but not limited to, Tenament' employees, monitors or hosts. User shall not hold himself or herself out or portray himself or herself as a Tenament staff member or employee while engaging in all forms of online communication, including, but not limited to, member names, member profiles, voice, text or graphic chat, message postings or any form of communication on line. Impersonation of Tenament staff shall be grounds for immediate account termination.
23. Do not engage in "disruptive behavior" in chat areas, game areas, bulletin boards, or any other area of the Services. Disruptive behavior shall be deemed to include, but will not be limited to, conduct which purposefully interferes with the normal flow of dialogue in a Service area. Disruptive behavior shall also include, but not be limited to, commercial postings, solicitations and advertisements.
24. Do not post or transmit chain letters or pyramid marketing schemes. This type of material places an unnecessary load on the Services and is considered a nuisance by many members. Certain types of chain letters and pyramid schemes are also illegal. Such prohibited conduct includes, but is not limited to, the transmission of letters or messages which offer a product or service and which are based on the structure of a chain letter.
25. Do not post or transmit unsolicited advertising, promotional materials, or other forms of solicitation. Tenament services are not to be used to send unsolicited advertising, promotional material, or other forms of solicitation to other members. You may not use Tenament services to collect or "harvest" member names without the express permission of those members. Tenament reserves the right to block and/or filter mass email solicitations on or through the service.
26. Do not violate any operating rule, policy or guideline of any other online service. User further agrees to abide by the rules of User's Internet service provider.
27. Do not violate, intentionally or unintentionally, any applicable local, state, national or international law or regulation.
28. Do not modify any files which Tenament does not specifically authorize User to modify. Use of material which is subject to the rights of any person or entity without the express permission of such rights holder is prohibited, and will result in the termination of User's membership and possible civil and/or criminal liability.

29. Do not post to many bulletin boards at once and/or send multiple unsolicited emails to a single address, sometimes referred to as "spamming," is prohibited. Tenament may take action on User's account if any of the following offenses is reported: (a) Posting a similar or identical message to more than 5 bulletin boards; (b) Sending unsolicited mail to more than 25 people or (c) Sending more than two (2) unsolicited emails to a single email address. Repeated spamming will result in account termination.

The following is a set of rules which are to be followed at all times by the Administrators. You have agreed to these rules when you agreed to take on the duties and privileges of an Administrator. Failure to follow these rules could lead to a ban and loss of your Administrator privileges.

1. Follow all of the rules listed in the above User section.
2. Log all administrative actions you take into the admin forum.
3. Do not talk to the users about administrative issues (ie. don't gossip).
4. Do not contradict other administrators. Take all issues to the admin forum.
5. Do not use your administrative privileges to threaten or intimidate the users.
6. **ABSOLUTELY DO NOT LOG INTO YOUR ADMINISTRATOR ACCOUNT FROM A PUBLIC COMPUTER!**
7. Do not delete threads. You may lock threads and move them to the admin forum.
8. Do not delete users.
